Subject: Reminder NJ VFC Goes "Green" January 1, 2012

MEMO

The New Jersey Vaccines for Children (NJVFC) Program would like to remind all of its pediatric and adult providers that after December 31, 2011 we will no longer accept any written/faxed orders for vaccines. NJVFC continues to offer online provider training in using our Inventory Management Order and Distribution System (IMODS) and I urge you to take advantage of one of these trainings. IMODS training is offered almost daily and signing up is easy at <https://njiis.nj.gov/njiis/jsp/trainingschedule.jsp>. The training is completed at the comfort of your own computer in one hour.

Concurrently, the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Service's mandate goes into effect which states that every health care provider administering vaccines to children under 7 shall register as a New Jersey Immunization Information System (NJIIS) site and enter vaccinations within 30 days of administration (N.J.S.A. 26:4-131 et seq. and rules at N.J.A.C. 8:57-3).

Please keep these items in mind as the year quickly draws to an end and the NJ VFC Program appreciates your continued immunization efforts throughout the state.
