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The New Jersey Vaccines for Children Program is pleased to announce the availability of three new vaccines - Gardasil 9 (HPV), Trumenba (Meningococcal B) and Bexsero (Meningococcal B).

**Gardasil 9** (Merck), new 9 valent HPV vaccine:

- The NJ VFC Program will phase out fulfilling orders for Gardasil 4. Please continue to use any remaining Gardasil 4 doses on male patients that present for vaccination. Order enough doses of Gardasil 9 to last until your next ordering month, while maintaining a safety stock.
- Gardasil 9 is not available on the 317/adult contract at this time.

**Bexsero** (Novartis) and **Trumenba** (Wyeth), new Meningococcal B vaccines:

- The pediatric recommendations for Meningococcal B vaccine targets children ages 10-18 years who are at increased risk for meningococcal disease attributable to serogroup B, including children with immune deficiencies and children at increased risk of a disease outbreak attributable to serogroup B.
- Since the Meningococcal serogroup B Vaccines are recommended only for certain high-risk patients, the quantity available will be limited.
- Meningococcal B vaccines are not available for 317/adults at this time.
